National Convention Cancelled due to the Covid-19

In the first time since 1919, The National Convention which was to be held in Louisville, KY has been cancelled. The National Executive Committee, in association with the National Commander and Adjutant, decided for the safety of all Legion Family members to cancel.

This decision did not come easy and many throughout National was still hoping to have the National Convention. All National Elected Officers will be rolled over to the next year. All Commission and Committee Chairman and its members will also be held over. All visits by the National Commander, Leading Candidate, Spring Meetings, visits by any National Representative are cancelled. National is hoping that the restrictions are lifted shortly.

Louisville will be offered the 2026 National Convention.

National is still planning on the National Fall Conference this October at the National Headquarters in Indianapolis.

DEPARTMENT CONVENTION
